

**Oriel Q Gallery** occupies the second floor in Narberth's Queen's Hall and can be reached by both stairs and lift. It consists of three areas. The Main Gallery exhibits paintings, photographs, prints, textiles, sculpture, and much more. Oriel Fach usually has a separate programme – one that enables installations, videos and sculptures, or it is used to display a continuation of the main exhibition. The 3D area showcases ceramics, jewellery and small sculptures. No space is wasted: even the stairs up to the gallery are utilised – mainly for photographic exhibitions.

The exhibition area is open on Wednesday, Thursday, Friday and Saturday, 10.00am to 5.00pm, although viewing of work may be possible on Monday and Tuesday if the space is not needed for community use.

The Gallery Manager is **Lynne Crompton**.

### What is *Oriel Q Friends*?

It is a group formed in November 1999 to help raise funds to pay the rent of the room used as a gallery and to support the running of it.

Since that time, the *Friends* have provided physical help, time and, when required, money to make improvements to the gallery. Examples include redecoration, provision of a new projector and screen, and minding of the gallery during the curator's well-earned holidays.

In September 2012, *Oriel Q Friends* became a registered charity.
